

IDEA Disability Category: Intellectual Disability

Intellectual Disability can range from a very mild cognitive impairment to a profound disability which limits the child's ability to think and behave like children of her/his own age. The Regulations define ID as significantly below- average intellectual functioning combined with deficits in adaptive behavior which shows up during the child's developmental period and which adversely affects the child's educational performance.
